Ms Shepherd said Cardea's oil is listed with the Therapeutic Goods Administration as a recognised complementary medicine, providing consumers with a level of confidence in the oil's many therapeutic benefits. The company is also committed to ongoing product testing to ensure customers receive the highest quality, organic pomegranate seed oil available.

Due to its high antioxidant activity, Cardea's exclusive pomegranate seed oil delivers a wide range of health and cosmetic benefits, fighting free radicals that damage and age the skin and maintaining skin vitality. Ms Shepherd said the product is easy for people to incorporate into their regular daily skincare routine to achieve long-term health benefits.

Applied topically and absorbed into the skin, the rich fatty acids within pomegranate seed oil are known to protect the skin, smooth wrinkles and help soothe and hydrate dry, cracked, mature and irritated skin.



It provides emolliency, protects skin from the drying effects of wind and sun, and supports a wide variety of conditions such as eczema and dermatitis.

"I am delighted to be able to provide - for the first time - the highest-quality pomegranate seed oil to the Australian market."

Ms Shepherd expects the national launch of the product to attract widespread consumer interest, meeting the growing demand for the highly sought-after seed oil across the country.
